Vincent's appearance is unkempt. He reports that his insomnia has returned, and he feels hopeless.

Alcohol Overuse Disorder & Homelessness

Nisha is in alcohol withdrawal, and wants medication to manage her withdrawal symptoms.



Suicidal Ideation

Nisha's friends are concerned for her safety after finding a "goodbye note" and have brought her to the Emergency Department.



Medication Seeking

Vincent came in for a follow up visit requesting more sleeping pills. His last visit was 3 weeks ago.



Generalized Anxiety Disorder (GAD)

Vaughn is reluctantly seeking care for stress and exhaustion.

Essential Care



Healthy Routine Physical

Alex is here for his annual physical exam.



Abdominal Pain

Emily has been having abdominal pain the last 3 days. She was hoping it would go away, but it's getting worse.



Acute Headache

Valerie is at her wit's end with these constant headaches, and medication is no longer helping.



Inclusive Sexual Health

Vivian is a new patient at the practice, establishing care. She's also hoping to renew her contraception prescription.

Acute Care



STEMI

Alex was at home last night watching TV when he had a sudden onset of mild chest pain.



Angina

Ray has been having chest pain with exertion for over a month, but it's progressing and he now has jaw pain.



CHF

Richard is experiencing shortness of breath and occasional chest pressure.



COPD

Annette can't seem to catch her breath, and it's getting progressively harder for her to breathe.



Pneumonia

Betty has come to the ER feverish, nauseous, and wheezing.



Allergic Reaction

Mackenzie's boyfriend brought her from the restaurant they were eating at because of sudden shortness of breath.



GERD

Vikki has had recurring chest pain over the past year that lasts 15-20 minutes then dissipates.

Complex Procedures



Hypertensive Emergency (Arterial Line)

Aarón was admitted with severe headache, shortness of breath, and chest pain. He needs arterial line placement.



Hemodialysis Access Failure (Central Line)

Cecil is in the hospital with a need for vascular access for hemodialysis due to his end-stage renal disease.



Respiratory Distress (Endotracheal Intubation)

Elliot was urgently admitted to the hospital due to acute hypoxic respiratory failure. He requires immediate intubation and mechanical ventilation.



Symptomatic Shortness of Breath (Paracentesis)

Patrick presented to the hospital with abdominal distension, discomfort, and increasing abdominal girth over the past few weeks.



Dyspnea from Pleural Effusion (Thoracentesis)

Thelma has worsening dyspnea and a persistent dry cough that has developed over the past three weeks.

Inpatient Care



Internal Bleed

Deshawn had surgery for colon cancer, and is two hours post-surgery. He is in pain, finds it hard to stay awake.



Discharge MVA (Substance Abuse)

James was brought to the ER by ambulance, after a minor car accident, and wants to be discharged.



Pulmonary TB w/Liver Complications

Juan is admitted for pulmonary tuberculosis with liver complications.



Ischemic Stroke

Martha is complaining of sudden dizziness, unexpected and sharp headache and right side weakness. She is in hospital, a day after surgery.



Stump Appendicitis & Sepsis

Ruth had an appendectomy 4 days ago. She's returned to the hospital because of abdominal pain, fever, nausea, vomiting and malaise.

Outpatient Care



Influenza (Seeking Antibiotics)

Vernon can't seem to beat his cough, running nose and sore throat. He demands antibiotics to get back to work.



Diabetes Follow Up

Vanessa missed her last appointment and is in the office today at her adult daughter's insistence.



Carpal Tunnel

Moses has been having weakness in his right hand making it difficult for him to work.



Gallbladder Disease

Cassie has had abdominal pain for the past week.



Acute Renal Failure

Anthony, at the behest of his family, is seeking care due to recent episodes of confusion and forgetfulness.



Cholelithiasis

Mary left a family barbecue with epigastric pain, diarrhea and vomiting.
